1. Statement of Intent

Veraxus Ltd is committed, so far as is reasonably practicable, to protecting the health, safety and welfare of employees, workers, labour-only subcontractors, subcontracted support, visitors, clients, occupants and members of the public who may be affected by company activities.

The company will conduct construction, refurbishment, maintenance, flooring, fit-out, repair, survey, mobilisation, handover and associated business activities in a safe, planned and controlled manner. This commitment applies wherever Veraxus Ltd undertakes, manages, coordinates or controls work, and where Veraxus Ltd workers attend client, principal contractor or occupied environments.

2. Company commitments

- Comply with applicable health and safety legislation, including the Health and Safety at Work etc. Act 1974, Management of Health and Safety at Work Regulations and CDM 2015 duties relevant to the company role on each project.
- Identify hazards, assess risks and prepare suitable controls before work starts.
- Provide and maintain safe systems of work, suitable tools, PPE, welfare arrangements and project-specific instructions where relevant.
- Use competent people and require subcontracted support to follow Veraxus Ltd, client and principal contractor health and safety requirements.
- Communicate risk controls through RAMS, inductions, toolbox talks, site briefings, supervision and clear project instructions.
- Prevent accidents, injuries, ill health, occupational exposure and unsafe conduct through planning, monitoring and review.
- Encourage early reporting of hazards, near misses, incidents, health concerns and unsafe conditions without retaliation.

3. Plan, Do, Check, Act control route

Stage	Practical meaning
Plan	Review scope, site conditions, competence, access, welfare, hazards and client requirements before work starts.
Do	Apply RAMS, supervision, PPE, tools, communication, welfare and site-specific controls.
Check	Inspect, monitor, review near misses, act on concerns and check controls remain effective.
Act	Correct defects, update methods, brief lessons learned and improve arrangements.

4. Responsibilities and arrangements

Role	Health and safety responsibility
Director / senior management	Overall responsibility for policy, resources, planning, competent support, monitoring and review.
Project lead / supervisor	Implement site controls, brief workers, monitor work, stop unsafe activity, report concerns and maintain records.
Workers and labour-only operatives	Take reasonable care, follow instructions and RAMS, use PPE correctly, report hazards and avoid unsafe behaviour.
Subcontractors and suppliers	Cooperate with Veraxus Ltd and client requirements, provide competent support, follow site rules and escalate risks early.
External competent support	Provide health and safety advice, RAMS review, inspections or specialist guidance where needed.

5. Review and linked documents

This Statement of Intent is reviewed annually or earlier if work activities, legislation, client requirements, insurance conditions, SSIP feedback, incidents or company arrangements materially change. It is supported

by the full Health and Safety Policy and by project-specific RAMS, inductions, COSHH assessments, training/competence records, emergency arrangements and monitoring records where relevant.
